Arrival Guide:

Vaclav Havel Airport Prague is the closest international airport to Prague, situated few kilometres west from Prague. From the **Vaclav Havel Airport Prague** you can travel to the **FEE** (CTU campus) either by public transport or by TAXI. Prices for the public transport tickets are as follows:

- Single ticket: 32 CZK (approx. 1.2 EUR, ticket is valid 90 minutes),
- 1 day ticket: 110 CZK (approx. 3.9 EUR),
- 3 days ticket: 310CZK (approx. 11.1 EUR).

Transportation from the Vaclav Havel Airport Prague to the FEE (CTU campus):

- Public transport (trip takes about 30 minutes) – shortest/recommended route:

1. To travel from the **Airport** to the “**Nadrazi Veleslavin**” take the **BUS 119**, please.
2. From the “**Nadrazi Veleslavin**” take subway line “**A**” (green line on the subway map) and travel to “**Dejvicka**” station (50.1006061N, 14.3921342E).

Then either:

3a. Then take “**Solinova**” street to arrive to “**Technicka**” street (approx. 200 m).

4a. Enter the FEE building and go to second floor - COST BM1309 Meeting will be held in lecturing room 209.

Or:

3b. Take “**Evropska**” street to arrive to “**Thakurova**” street (approx. 400 m).

4b. Enter the “**MK**” building and go Congress Hall on the ground floor.

- TAXI (trip takes about 15 minutes):

From the **Vaclav Havel Airport Prague** to the **FEE** (CTU campus): trip approx. 10 km, typical taxi fare is around 500 CZK (approx. 18 EUR). But we recommend you to take exact information from taxi driver before you start the trip!

Accommodation:

It is possible to have accommodation right in “[Masarykova Kolej](#)”. It is a 3-star hotel (not luxury, but correct) with a price of 620 CZK (approx. 25 EUR) for single room and 1040 CZK (approx. 40 EUR) for double room (including breakfast in both cases). Indicate, please, in your email, that you are participant of the „COST BM1309“ meeting.
